To avoid the risks that are always present when you use any product fitted to a vehicle, it is important that the Tapered Wall with Window & Stove Jack is installed correctly and that you read the safety instructions contained in this manual carefully to avoid misuse and hazards.

We recommend that this manual is kept in the glove-box of the vehicle that the Tapered Wall with Window & Stove Jack is used with, so it can be used for future reference or handover to any future owners.

After unpacking the Dune Tapered Wall with Window & Stove Jack please check that it is not damaged and that all parts have been supplied with the kit before installation.

Packaging disposal

- Installation work must be performed in accordance with any local, state and national Standards.

Conditions of Use

This tapered extension is intended to be used in stationary SUV, 4WD, RV and similar applications such as for:

- Shade
- Picnics
- Camping
- · Service and repair



Use of Stove Jack

The stove jack in this awning is designed to accommodate a stove for heating and cooking purposes. However, improper use of the stove jack can lead to serious injury or even death. Please read and follow these guidelines carefully before using the stove jack. If you have a stove installed in your awning wall, it is important to take some safety precautions to prevent accidents or fires. Here are some steps you can take:

- 1. Always make sure that the stove jack is properly installed and sealed. Any gaps or leaks can allow hot gases or sparks to escape and potentially start a fire.
- 2. Use a stove that is designed for use with a stove jack. Make sure that the stove is in good condition and that all parts are functioning properly.
- 3. Keep the area around the stove clear of flammable materials such as paper, cloth, or wood. Make sure that there are no overhanging branches or other hazards that could ignite from the heat of the stove.
- 4. Use a heat shield to protect the wall and surrounding area from the heat of the stove. This can be a sheet of metal or other non-flammable material placed between the stove and the wall.
- 5. Have a fire extinguisher nearby in case of emergency. Make sure that you and anyone else who will be using the stove know how to use it.
- 6. Never leave the stove unattended while it is in use. Always make sure that it is properly extinguished before leaving the area, taking care when packing away to not burn yourself.

By taking these precautions, you can enjoy the warmth and comfort of your stove while minimizing the risk of accidents or fires.



Connect to Dune 270° Awning

- Fully set up and secure the awning that the Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack is to be connected to (In accordance with applicable installation instructions) ensuring that all necessary straps, poles, pegs, and guy ropes are in place. Unpack the Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack and set it out on a clean space on the ground directly in front of the awning it is to be connected to.
- 2. Facing towards the awning attach the zipper on the upper front left-hand side of the Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack to the zipper on the underside (outside on older awnings) of the left-hand side front edge of the awning using the fitted zippers, to the awning section(s) as required. Fully attach the Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack to the awning by zipping from left .to right.




3. **Wall Configuration**: Extend Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack, peg-out to secure, refer to below.



Note: The Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack can be connected as a wall to any or all of the four canopy sections of a Dune 270° Awning.

4. **Enclosure Configuration:** Extend the Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack, velcro the panels together then zip panels together as required, refer to below images A & B. Peg-out to secure.



Note: The Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack can be connected as a wall to any or all of the four canopy sections of a Dune 270° Awning. To create a full enclosure, you will need to buy additional Dune Tapered Walls.



5. Awning Tapered Wall Configuration for Shade: Install the 2 x 3 Stage 2.2m (87") Telescopic Poles with Peggable Foot supplied on the front of the Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack. Fit and/or extend all guy ropes and pegs to secure the wall.

Notes:

- During heavy rain or strong winds lower the poles at the front of the Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack.
- The Dune Tapered Wall with Window and Stove Jack can be connected as a wall to any or all of the four canopy sections of a Dune 270° Awning, or for extra shade, see below illustration.



This product is guaranteed to be free from defects in workmanship & materials for a period of 12 months from date of purchase.

The product will be replaced or refunded for a major failure. The product will be repaired or replaced at our discretion should the product fail to be of an acceptable quality and failure is not a major failure.

Warranty will not apply if the product (a) is damaged through misuse (including failure to maintain), neglect, accident or ordinary wear & tear (including rust, corrosion & normal fading, weathering, staining, discolouration, scratching or chipping); (b) is damaged through exposure to heat; (c) is used commercially; (d) has not been used or installed in accordance with any applicable instruction; or (e) has been modified, repaired or tampered with by the purchaser or an unauthorised service person.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

To claim under this warranty, take this product to any Anaconda store where you purchased it. You will need your receipt or other proof of purchase. Additional information may be requested of you to process your claim. Should you not be able to provide proof of purchase with a receipt; a bank or credit card statement, and identification showing your name, address and signature may be required to process your claim.
