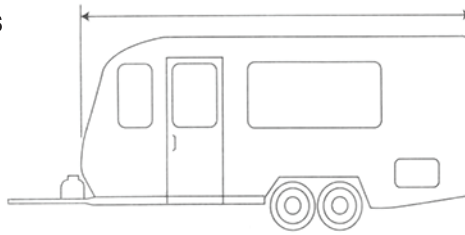


COVER FITTING GUIDE

Before you start lets go through a few things first. Have you purchased the correct sized cover? It's no good trying to fit a cover that's the wrong size. A quick measure of your van or RV will eliminate a whole lot of trouble. Simply measure using the images below as a guide.



Okay, if that all checks out, then we are almost ready to start. You basically need the following things: (1) a long handle broom, (2) a step ladder, (3) a cotton glove or similar, (4) some cloth or protective tape.

Dos

Ensure the caravan is clean & tidy before fitting cover.

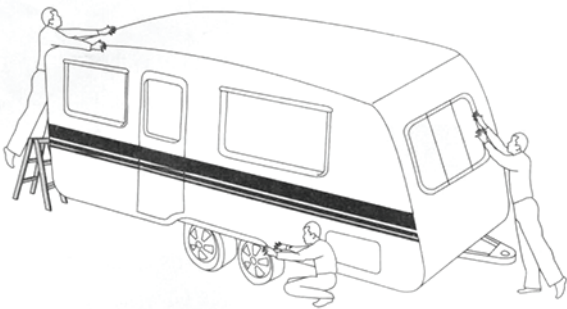
Inspect the caravan for sharp objects, edges and potential wear spots.

Dont's

Don't fit the cover during windy or rainy conditions.

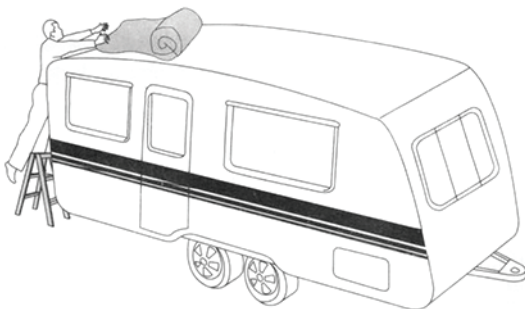
Don't use tent poles in place of a broom as they can damage the caravan or tear the cover itself.

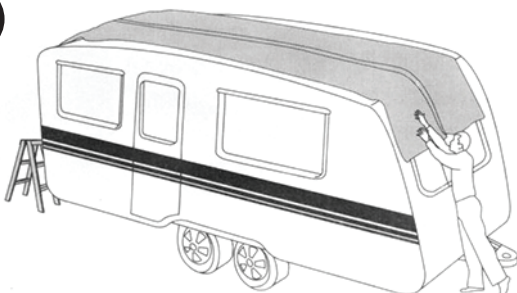
Before fitting the cover we recommend running your hand over the entire van using a cloth or protective glove to locate any sharp edges or objects which may catch on and tear the cover. Air conditioners, satellite dishes, solar panels, awnings and stabilisers are just some of the things that can have sharp edges which could damage the cover during installation. Place some adhesive cloth tap or similar over these areas.

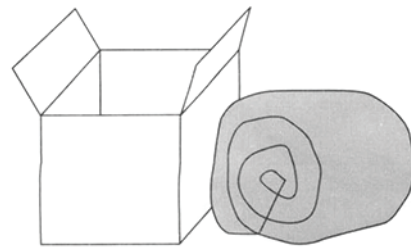
Position your step ladder at the rear of the caravan and place the rolled up cover on the roof as shown. Ensure your ladder is stable.

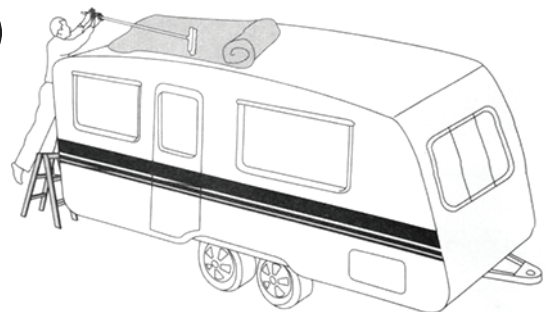
Starting at the front, begin to unfold the cover over the roof of the caravan until you reach the rear. For areas you can't reach use the broom to spread the cover.

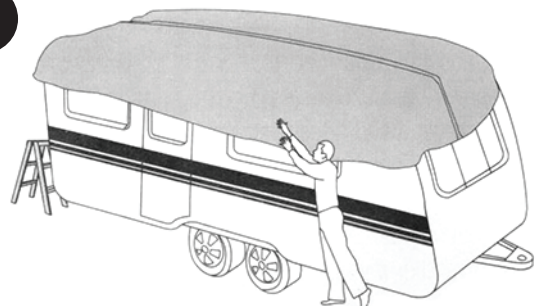
Carefully unpack the cover from the box, it should be pre-rolled and ready to use.

Roll the cover towards the front of the caravan using the long handle broom. You may need to reposition the step ladder to push the cover all the way.

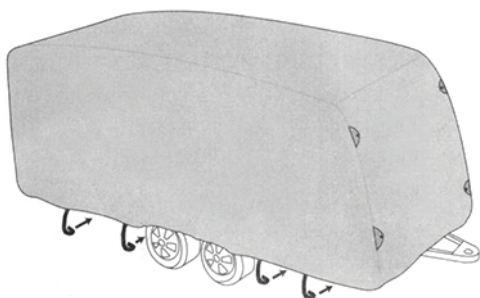

Walk around the caravan and gently pull the sides down. Keep adjusting the cover until it fits squarely on the caravan.

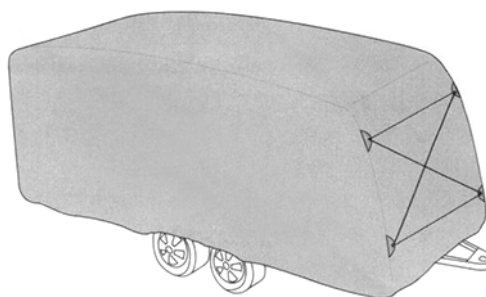

Connect and adjust the locking straps by passing them under the caravan and clipping together to secure the cover in place.

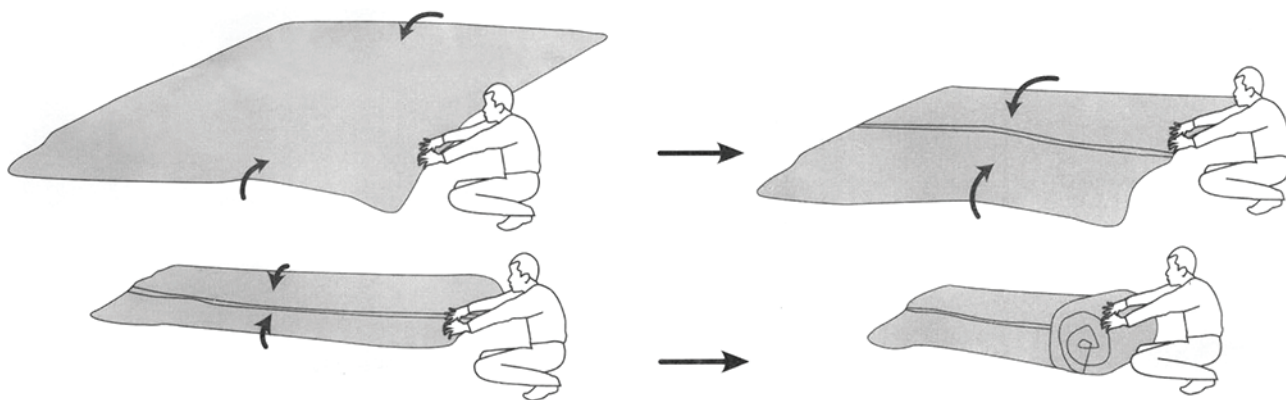


Finally, each cover features heavy duty reinforced tabs and comes with ropes designed to take up any excess material and further secures the cover in place. Do not over tighten the ropes.

REMOVING & STORING THE COVER

When removing the cover for storage it may be quicker to simply reverse the initial fitting procedures. This way the cover will be ready to be fitted as per the original instructions. If for some reason this is not possible, carefully remove the cover from the caravan and transfer it to a clean, dry location. Always take special care not to catch or tear the cover on any sharp or protruding accessories, objects or fittings during removal. When placing the cover on the ground, avoid any contamination to the interior lining of the material.

Carefully remove the cover from the vehicle and lay the cover out like a blanket with the outer surface facing upwards. Starting from one side of the cover, fold the sides toward the centre of the cover. Repeat this on the other side and keep folding until the cover is approximately two feet/600mm wide. Now roll the cover tightly as shown and place in the storage bag provided.



Dos	Dont's
Allow the cover to dry completely before storing away.	Don't use while towing or transporting your caravan or RV.
Place the cover in the bag supplied for added protection during storage.	Don't remove, fold or store the caravan cover while it is damp or wet.

Locating all possible wear and tear points on your caravan before fitment will reduce the likelihood of damage. Please be aware that severe winds may also cause damage if the cover is not properly fitted. If by chance the cover is damaged during fitment or storage, a self adhesive patch kit has been supplied with this cover. We recommend applying the patch fabric to both the inside and outside of the damaged area and the further application of protective tape. As an added precaution you may wish to pre-apply the patch material to certain areas of the cover that may be subjected to excessive wear. Please remember that any damage caused to the cover by extreme weather conditions is not covered under the product warranty. Contact your retailer if you require additional repair/protection patches.
