NATURE PHOTO FRAME

Materials

- ☐ Sturdy sticks or driftwood
- ☐ Twine
- ☐ Safety scissors
- ☐ Hole punch
- ☐ Clips or clothes pins
- ☐ Craft supplies, such as paint or colourful yarn (*optional*)
- ☐ Nature materials for decoration (*optional*)
- ☐ Glue (*optional*)

Instructions

1. Gather several sticks that are about the same length and thickness. You will need at least four similarly sized sticks. Also look for other nature materials that you can use for decorations.
2. Make a shape with your sticks, such as a square, rectangle or triangle. This will be your frame.
3. Attach the sticks to each other one corner at a time. Lay the end of one stick on top of the other. Cut a long piece of twine, and wrap it several times around the two pieces making an X shape. Tie a knot or a bow to secure it. Repeat for each corner.
4. Decorate your frame. Here are some ideas:
 - Weave brightly coloured yarn around each of the sticks.
 - Paint your sticks.
 - Attach dried leaves or dried flowers at the corners of your frame.
 - Widen or lengthen your frame by attaching additional sticks using yarn or twine.
